Extended Papers from the 2006 Radio and Wireless Symposium (RWS2006)

Publication Date: September 2006, Submission Deadline: January 9, 2006

The IEEE Transactions on Microwave Theory and Techniques (T-MTT), are scheduled to publish a Mini-Special Issue devoted to the Symposium with substantially extended papers based on papers that have been accepted for presentation in the 2006 IEEE Radio and Wireless Symposium (RWS2006). As a guide, papers submitted for publication in the Mini-Special Issue must have at least 60% new information as compared to that in the Symposium paper. In the T-MTT submission the Symposium paper should be put in context and there should be a minimum amount of repeated material. The papers must be submitted electronically. You must not submit your paper or the same results to another conference or journal while your paper is in consideration. Manuscripts submitted to the Mini-Special Issue will be subject to the same reviewing criteria as regular papers submitted to T-MTT. Authors of *invited* papers (as designated in the Advance Program, see www.radiowireless.org) are encouraged to submit expanded versions of their Symposium papers for possible publication in the IEEE Microwave Magazine, if such papers generally present a current overview of the state of the art in the development or deployment of various wireless systems and technologies or present a comprehensive tutorial on related topics of interest. The email submission procedure for T-MTT is:

1. The email must contain the following in the Subject Line:
'TMTT Manuscript RWS2006 < with the RWS paper ID (e.g. TU4A-2) >'
2. Submit the manuscript in single-spaced, two-column format as a pdf file attachment less than 1 MB in size named 'submission.pdf'. Minimize the amount of material duplicated from the Symposium paper. Put the Symposium paper in the proper context in your submission. Include the title of the paper and the author names at the top of your email.
3. Submit the final version of the accepted RWS paper as a pdf file attachment less than 1 MB in size named 'rws2006.pdf'. In the body of your e-mail you must specify the differences between your submission and the Symposium paper.
4. Include a fax number at which you can be contacted in case there are problems.
5. Send the email addresses of all authors.
6. Send your email to the Editor-In-Chief of the Transactions at TMTTeditor@ieee.org (The editor will respond within three days of your submission).
